## VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS

Please be advised that the North Shore Fire Department membership is presently low, and is in urgent need of recruitments.

Minimum qualifications are as follows:

- ✓ Be at least 18 years of age
- ✓ Valid Class "G" driver's licence and clean driving record
- ✓ Own or have immediate access to a vehicle for transportation to emergency scene
- ✓ Ability to pass a medical examination by a qualified medical doctor and be declared fit for duty
- ✓ Recent Driver's Abstract
- ✓ Vulnerable persons record check

Volunteer Firefighters are paid according to a points system (\$18.02/point) to attend training and emergency scenes, as well as applicable mileage.
