**North Shore Fire Department
Fire Prevention Week**

Fire Prevention Week is fast approaching, running from October 8 to 14 this year.

Each year, the North Shore Fire Department participates in Fire Prevention Week activities and promotions to educate the public on the importance of fire safety.

Please practice your home fire escape plan during Fire Prevention Week!

Township of the North Shore–Fire Chief Pelchat is urging families in throughout our Municipality to practice their home fire escape plan as part of Fire Prevention Week. This year's theme of Fire Prevention Week, which runs from October 8-14, 2017, is "Every Second Counts: Plan 2 Ways Out!"

"Fire and smoke move faster than you," said **Chief Pelchat**. "There's no time to figure out how to escape your home **AFTER** a fire starts. Practice an escape plan **BEFORE** there's a fire so you can get out safely."

In a fire, you may have just seconds to safely escape your home. Be prepared in advance with these simple steps for home fire escape planning:

- **Assess the needs of everyone in your home** Identify anyone who requires assistance to get out of the home safely, such as small children or older adults.
- **Make sure that you have working smoke alarms on every storey of the home and outside all sleeping areas.** Make sure everyone in the home knows the sound of the smoke alarm.
- **Identify all possible exits (doors and windows) and make sure they work and are not difficult to open.** Know two ways out of all areas, if possible.
- **Everyone must know what to do when the smoke alarm sounds.** Assign someone to help those who need assistance. Identify a safe meeting place outside. Call the fire department using 911 from outside the home – from a neighbour's home or a cell phone.
- **Practice your home fire escape plan at least twice a year.** Have everyone participate. Make changes to your plan if necessary.

Township of The North Shore VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS

The Township of The North Shore is seeking applications for Volunteer Firefighters.

Minimum qualifications are as follows:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Valid Class "G" driver's licence and clean driving record
- Own or have immediate access to a vehicle for transportation to emergency scene
- Ability to pass a medical examination by a qualified medical doctor and be declared fit for duty.

Volunteer Firefighters are paid according to a points system (\$17.75/point) to attend training and emergency scenes, as well as applicable mileage.

NORTH SHORE HEALTH NETWORK FOUNDATION

Last year the North Shore Health Network Foundation (NSHN) held a Break Away raffle in support of the three North Shore Health Network sites in Richards Landing, Thessalon, and Blind River. The raffle raised a total of \$9,000 or \$3,000 per site for necessary medical equipment.

The Foundation is holding the raffle again this year. The prizes are:

1st Prize - 2 tickets to a Toronto Maple Leafs game, 2 nights' accommodations, airfare, & \$500

2nd Prize - a \$400 spa package for two, 2 nights' accommodations, a dining certificate, & \$250

The proceeds will help fund: a portable Digital X-ray for the Richards Landing-Matthew Site in 2017-18; Digital X-ray equipment for the Thessalon Site 2018-19; and a Cardiac Monitoring System for the Blind River Site-Emergency Department in 2017-18.

The tickets will be sold until the draw date of January 12th 2018.

GARBAGE & RECYCLING BIN SITES

THIS AREA IS MONITORED BY VIDEO SURVEILLANCE

Township of The North Shore Council would like to remind residents that all three (3) garbage & recycling bin sites are being monitored by video surveillance and that **NEW Bylaw 15-36**, with set fines, passed Nov. 2, 2015 **will be enforced.**

Garbage bins are for household garbage only. All construction and building materials are to be brought to the Serpent River Landfill Site. No fire place or woodstove ashes.

Recycling will prolong the life of our landfill site. Recycling flyers are available at the municipal office and there is a link on our website for instructions of proper recycling methods.
