**Stay Fire Safe While Staying Warm**

Heating equipment is a leading cause of home fires in Ontario.



What heating equipment in my home can cause fires?

Fireplaces and Fireplace inserts. Woodstoves. Chimneys.

How do I keep myself and my loved ones safe?

Ensure woodstoves, fireplaces and fireplace inserts are installed by a qualified technician according to manufacturer's instructions. Have your heating system, vents and chimneys inspected and cleaned annually by a qualified service technician. Ensure all outside heating vents are not blocked.

Install smoke and carbon monoxide alarms on every storey of your home. Test them every month.

Allow ashes from your woodstove or fireplace to cool before emptying them into a metal container with a tight-fitting lid. Keep the container outside. Always use a fire screen around the fireplace!

**Curbside delivery service: Tuesday and Thursday 10am - 2pm**

How to request curbside delivery services (FIVE ITEM LIMIT):

- Place items on hold using [blindriver.olsn.ca](http://blindriver.olsn.ca). Holds can also be placed by calling the library at 705-356-7616 or by emailing [brplcirc@ontario.net](mailto:brplcirc@ontario.net). You will receive a phone call or email saying holds are ready for pick up.
- When you receive the notification, you must call the library to schedule a pickup time.
- When you arrive for pick up, your items will be located at the back of the building with your first name on bin, with last name initial. It is very important that you arrive at your scheduled time, to adhere to the COVID-19 protocols.

\*Please note that because almost all libraries are closed across Ontario, we will not be able to order items from other libraries at this time.

## Returns

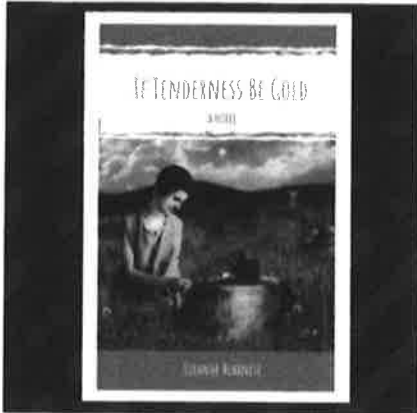
All items can be returned in our book drop located in the back of the building. Returning items will be quarantined for 72 hours before getting checked in. All library fines have been waived during this time.

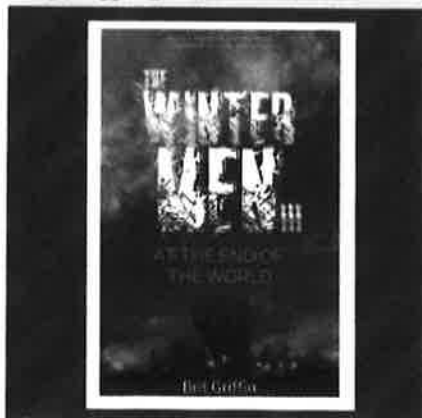


