

Letter from BAO

"Good Afternoon Rachel,

Thank you for contacting the Bereavement Authority of Ontario. I am happy to provide clarification on the issues surrounding damaged monuments and markers, as well the responsibilities of a cemetery operator as it relates to honouring interment rights in the cemetery, which included the rights to place monuments on lots and plots.

Your message refers both to old, damaged crosses and permanent monuments. Note that markers and monuments are permanent structures, generally deemed to be the property of the Interment Rights Holder(s)/ (IRHs), and must not be moved without the express written <u>consent of all IRHs</u>, unless a monument or marker poses an imminent risk to public safety.

In that case, a monument that is dangerous or leaning and poses a risk to bodily safety could be laid flush with the earth, or moved into temporary storage until it can be relevelled or repaired. Markers and monuments that have simply become unsightly due to age, wear and tear, dirt, etc., and pose no danger, **must not be moved.** Any efforts undertaken to restore or preserve monuments should only be done with the consent of the IRHs.

You may want to seek out professional services who specialize in cleaning and restoring monuments if such services are within your operating budget. Sometimes, local historical societies may wish to participate in these efforts or provide support for preservation activities.

On the other hand, temporary markers such as wooden crosses may be placed on lots by rights holders if this type of memorialization is permitted within your cemetery by-laws. Each cemetery operator may adopt their own rules as the legislation we enforce, the Funeral Burial and Cremation Services Act, (FBCSA 2002) is silent on this matter. Some by-laws will state a specific period after which temporary crosses will be removed by the operator (such as one year from the date of the interment.) If you take any action to remove temporary markers, be sure

that you are acting in a manner that is consistent with your most recent set of by-laws approved by the BAO. If your by-laws do not currently address removal and you had historically permitted it, you may only remove crosses that have become safety hazards.
