The Township of the North Shore has determined that it is in the public interest to prohibit camping on municipal property in order to protect persons from injury and property from damage and to eliminate the risk of liability.

Definitions:

"Camp" mean to set up or to remain in or at a campsite for the purpose of establishing or maintaining a temporary place to live.

"Campsite" means any place where any bedding, sleeping bag, or other sleeping matter or any stove or fire is placed, established or maintained, whether or not such place incorporates the use of any tent, lean-to, shack, trailer or any other structure or any vehicle such as a recreational vehicle (RV).

There will be no allowance for camping on any of the municipally owned properties.

Upon failure to vacate the premises upon notification, the campsite will be removed of its contents and the Trespass to Property Act will come into effect.
