2nd 2021 CLEAN UP WEEK

Sept. 7 - 10 Municipal Pickups Only

This is to accommodate the disposal of larger items and debris that does not normally qualify for collection during the rest of the year. The refuse should be easily accessible and should not include any hazardous materials.

Refrigerators and freezers have to be tagged to indicate that the Freon (a harmful, global-warming contributing chemical) has been removed or they will not be picked up. In addition, doors and lids to refrigerators and freezers must be removed before they are left outside for collection.

We are unable to remove derelict vehicles or heavy articles. E-waste (electronic waste) and tires are acceptable. The public works employee shall determine the acceptability of the refuse to the landfill site should this become an issue.

Residents should contact the municipal office at 705-849-2213 or

705-461-1821 during regular office hours Monday to Friday (9:00 am - 4:30 pm) to arrange for pick up during that week. Public works will then attend your residence and bring the refuse to the landfill site free of charge.

WHAT IS A WETT INSPECTION? WHEN DO I NEED A WETT INSPECTION?

A **W**ood Energy Technology Transfer inspection is a thorough inspection of your wood burning appliance by a certified technician.

What is included in a WETT inspection?

A WETT inspection includes:

- A detailed look at the chimney
- An evaluation of the liner and flue
- Smoke chamber check
- Inspection of the damper
- A close appraisal of the firebox
- A superficial and structural look at the hearth or floor around the appliance
- A general inspection of the surrounding area



DAYTIME BURNING PERMIT

At the Regular Council Meeting of May 19th 2021, Council passed Bylaw 21-28, which allows for the issuance of Daytime Burning Permits.

The fee for the Daytime Burning Permit is \$20 for **1 month** from the date of purchase. This permit covers between 7AM and 7PM

Once the permit has been issued, the Fire Chief or Designate must inspect the location of the daytime burning before burning can begin.

2021 Final Property Taxes

The 2021 final property tax bills have been issued on July 12th, 2021.

1st installment due date: August 31st, 2021 2nd installment due date: October 29th, 2021

Please retain your final property tax bill for income tax purposes.

Penalty and Interest for Late Payment

Please be advised that a penalty of 1.25% will be applied to your property tax account if your payment is not received in full by the Township by the installment due date. An interest charge of 1.25% will also be applied to your property tax account on the 1st of every month thereafter for as long as the installment remains unpaid

Tax Arrears Notice

If you have property taxes that are **past due**, please note that the full balance is now due along with all late payment charges.

Properties that are two or more years in property tax arrears are eligible for the tax registration process. In order to avoid incurring collection costs and in order to avoid jeopardizing the ownership of your property, your attention to this matter is urgent.

Property Tax Bills

Please contact the Municipal Office if:

- you have not received a tax bill;
- your mailing address has changed;
- you would like your account balance;
- you have received a tax bill, but no longer own the property;
- you would like to inquire about payment options;
- you have received a reminder notice for an account you thought was paid.

Supplementary/Omitted Tax Billings

The Township issues supplementary/omitted tax bills for the following reasons:

- a change to your property, such as an addition, new construction or renovation;
- MPAC assessed a structure on your property for the first time;
- there was a change to your property's classification.

Property tax dollars associated with any changes are retroactive to the "effective date" provided by MPAC, which may be the date of occupancy or the date when the renovation or alterations were completed. The Township can assist in setting you up with a payment plan to help minimize the impact.

FIRE SAFETY AND PUBLIC EDUCATION OVERVIEW

The Fire Protection and Prevention Act 1997 requires that municipalities establish a program which must include public education with respect to fire safety. The Public Safety Education Section of the Office of the Fire Marshall and Emergency Management (OFMEM) develops materials and resources to assist municipal fire departments in their local public fire safety education efforts to raise public awareness of fire prevention and fire safety and protection form the dangers of carbon monoxide in their communities.

Everyone has the responsibility to keep their families and homes safe from fire and carbon monoxide.

The best ways to do so are to:

- Prevent fires from starting
- Maintain working smoke alarms on every storey of your home and outside all sleeping areas to have as much time to safely escape as possible, if a fire does occur. Not only do smoke alarms save lives, they are required by law
- Plan and practice a home fire escape plan so everyone in the home knows exactly what to do should the smoke alarms sound in an emergency
- Have fuel-burning appliances serviced annually by certified service technicians and install and maintain working carbon monoxide alarms adjacent to each sleeping area
- Consider installing residential sprinklers when building a new home or doing extensive renovations
